OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Child Protection Resource Center (CPRC) aims to contribute on the development of rights-based child protection system through empowering child protection workers and other relevant staff.

To develop a center that disseminates, builds capacity and empowers professional social work methodology of child protection and contributes to strengthening safe environment for every child using rights based approach to programming.

OUR PRINCIPLES

CPRC adheres to the following principles in its activities:

- Respect the best interests of children and provide safe and peaceful environment within their families;
- Encourage cooperation and partnership for delivering participation-based effective child protection services involving child participation, and
- Consider child protection workers as adult learners and respect their knowledge, skills, experiences, professionalism and individuality.

> OUR ACTIVITY FRAMEWORK

CPRC aims to build capacities for child protection workers and other relevant staff.



TRAINING

Regularly organize trainings, in classrooms, on the job, modular, and context based trainings for the child protection workers and other relevant staff.



Curriculum, textbook and guidance:

Provide methodological assistance for developing resource materials including curriculum, textbook and guidance on child protection.



RESEARCH

Scientifically study the challenges and problems of a child protection system, participate in studies and researches.



INFORMATION

Establish rich database on child protection issues and regularly sharing information and data.



Library: Over 600 books of 190 different kinds in Mongolian language and over 500 books of 150 different kinds in English language are available at the library to be used onsite or borrowed at home for social workers who work in the field of child protection and students who are majoring in the field.



CONSULTATION

Provide regular professional consultation for child protection workers and relevant staff, and provide counseling for needed children and families.



On the job consultation: Give face-to-face advice on child rights, child protection and especially on case management, including child abuse, neglect and provide advice about the responsibilities of professional social workers at their work place.



Open workshop: Invite scholars and professionals on the theoretical and practical issues of child protection and social work and organize workshops.



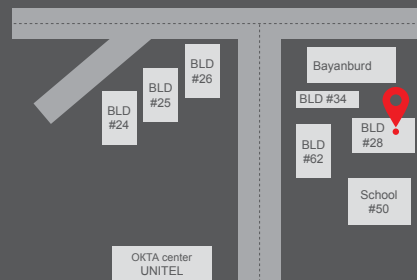
ADVOCACY
